COMMUNICATIONS CENTER MANAGEMENT

Sessions will enable managers to create a powerful impact on their employees and their agency by focusing on issues directly related to operating a communications center and mentoring.

CUTTING EDGE DEVELOPMENTS

These sessions will cover the most relevant and impactful developments in public safety communications.

CYBERSECURITY FOR PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS

This track will cover multiple aspects of cybersecurity, such as preparing for, preventing, mitigating and recovering from cyber threats and attacks.

- ✓ The Convention Center has electrostatic sprayer machines that deliver disinfecting solutions to the front, back and sides of surfaces and provide superior disinfectant coverage for better protection, including against coronavirus.
- ✓ Disinfectant wipes will be provided at various service counters.

The Anaheim Convention Center has received GBAC Star accreditation from the Global Biorisk Advisory Council, a division of ISSA, Inc., the leading association for the cleaning industry. 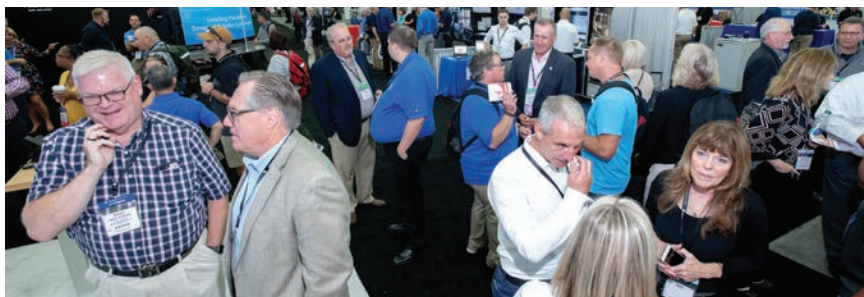
